We are a family practice, the broad range of special interests and skills within our team include family medicine, women's health, minor surgery, children's health, mental health, preventative or lifestyle health, men's health, dermatology, diabetes care, long term condition care, and many more.

We have a very experienced nursing team and offer a comprehensive nursing service including immunisations, flu and travel vaccines, phlebotomy, Aclasta, IV Antibiotics, wound management, Spirometry and 24 hour blood pressure monitoring to name just a few. We also offer minor surgeries at our clinic.

### Crawford Specialist Clinic, 12 Picton St

At 12 Picton Street in Howick we offer Ear Suctioning, Mole Mapping and other specialist services such as gynaecology, dermatology, audiology, gastroenterology, psychology and many more.

We offer an ear health service by a qualified Ear Nurse Specialist. This is done under a microscope and low-pressure suction technology. Our Ear Nurse is also ACC registered. The service includes removal of foreign objects, wax removal, ear infection and discharge, hearing loss and unsettled perforation.

We also have a comprehensive Mole Mapping clinic that will provide you with the most accurate melanoma and skin cancer detection and monitoring available.


